Please add the following entry.

	Must not donate if:
	 a) there is history of excessive bleeding or bruising b) there is a history of repeated joint dislocation involving the upper limbs
Obligatory	
	If the condition is mild and donor is not prone to excessive bruises or
Discretionary	bleeding, even if taking analgesics for joint pain, accept
See if Relevant	Cardiovascular Disease Drug Index Autoimmune Disease
	Ehlers Danlos syndrome is usually a mild condition which typically presents with hypermobility of joints, joint pains and tendency to bruising. Most donors are treated symptomatically, usually with analgesics for joint pains.
	If there is doubt about the diagnosis or severity, refer to a Designated Clinical Support Officer.
